## **NOTIFICATION**

No. 9-4/2024-U.3(A): Whereas, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an Institution of higher learning as an Institution deemed to be University.

- 2. And whereas, an online application dated 21.12.2023 was submitted by Chandramma Educational Society on UGC's Portal for grant of Institution Deemed to be University status under Distinct Category to Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana consisting of the following colleges under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956:
  - i. Malla Reddy Institute of Pharmaceuticals Sciences, Hyderabad
  - ii. Malla Reddy College of Engineering for Women, Hyderabad
- iii. Malla Reddy Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad
- iv. Malla Reddy Medical College for Women, Hyderabad
- v. Malla Reddy Institute of Dental Sciences, Hyderabad
- vi. Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, Hyderabad and
- vii. Malla Reddy College of Nursing, Hyderabad
- 3. And whereas, UGC, vide its letter No. 41-2/2023 (CPP-I/DU) dated 18.07.2024, informed that the application was examined by its Expert committee in accordance with the UGC (Institutions deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023. The Expert Committee recommended for issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI) to Chandramma Educational Society for fulfilment of certain conditions before grant of deemed to be University status under distinct category to Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana.
- 4. **And whereas**, the Commission considered and approved the recommendation of UGC Expert Committee in its 581<sup>st</sup> meeting (Item No. 7.02) held on 25.06.2024.
- 5. And whereas, the Ministry of Education, on the advice of UGC, issued Letter of Intent (LOI) to Chandramma Educational Society for fulfilment of the following conditions within a period of three years:
  - i. A legal undertaking to the effect that all the relevant rules & regulations and norms of the statutory authorities be complied with letter and spirit.
  - The Society shall submit plans for capacity building of faculty to teaching specialized and innovative courses.
  - iii. The Society shall submit plans for placements for passing out students.



- iv. A legal undertaking to the effect that Nursing seats intake shall be enhanced proportionately with medical courses to ensure that the objectives of introducing specialized courses are taken care of.
- v. The sponsoring body shall submit notarized affidavit to the effect that the entire moveable and immovable assets allocated to the institution deemed to be University shall not be leased or otherwise disposed of without the prior permission of the commission and make available the necessary infrastructure for operating the institution deemed to be University without any rental or other such charges.
- vi. A Corpus Fund of rupees twenty-five crores shall be created and maintained in the name of the institution deemed to be University.
- vii. The Society shall recruit necessary faculty members with the minimum qualification prescribed by the regulatory body concerned.
- viii. The Society shall submit the NOC from the Universities with which all the proposed constituent units are affiliated.
- ix. The Society shall submit a legal undertaking to the effect that it shall abide by all the provisions of the Act, rules and regulations made under the UGC Act, 1956.
- 6. And further whereas, the Chairman, Chandramma Educational Society, vide letter No. CES/Chair/2024-2025/001 dated 31.07.2024, submitted compliance report in respect of the conditions mentioned in the Letter of Intent (LoI). UGC placed the compliance report before the same Expert Committee which had recommended for issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI). The Expert Committee accepted the compliance report of the Institution.
- 7. And whereas, the recommendation of UGC Expert Committee was considered and approved by the Commission in its 583<sup>rd</sup> meeting (Item No.7.01) held on 27.08.2024.
- 8. **Now, therefore**, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Ministry of Education, on the advice of the UGC, hereby declares Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana consisting of above mentioned seven constituent units as an Institution deemed to be University under distinct category. The said declaration is subject to the following conditions:
  - There shall be no diversion of assets or funds/revenues of the Institution deemed to be University/or of its constituent teaching units, without prior permission of the UGC and Ministry of Education.
- ii. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana as well as its constituent units shall not engage or indulge in any activities that are of commercial and profit making in nature.
- iii. The academic programmes to be offered by Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall conform to the norms and standards prescribed by the UGC and other Statutory Councils/Bodies concerned.
- iv. The over-all performance of Constituent Institution(s) shall be monitored by the Commission as per the provisions of the extant Regulations and whose directions on management, academic development and improvement shall be binding on the Constituent Institution(s).

v. The Institute shall not keep confined only to presently new emerging areas but make endeavour to expand in other areas in accordance with the UGC Regulations / Guidelines as well as National Education Policy-2020.

vi. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall take all the required steps to get all the eligible academic courses/programmes rated for valid accreditation by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) and the Institute to get valid accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), as the case may be, in terms of the provisions as contained in the UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023, as amended from time to time.

vii. All the prescribed norms and procedures of the Statutory Councils concerned in the matter of admission of students, intake capacity of students, renewal of approval to the academic course / programme, revision of intake capacity of students, starting of new courses / programmes, etc. shall continue to be in force, and shall be adhered to by Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana.

viii. As and when necessary, the Institute shall update or revise or modify its MoA / Rules, as per the provisions of the prevailing Regulations of UGC.

ix. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall follow the fee structure as per the Rules and Regulations of the UGC and relevant Statutory Councils.

x. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall participate in annual Indian rankings issued by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of this Ministry.

xi. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall compulsorily create Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), identities of their students and upload their credit score in digital lockers and ensure that the credit scores are reflected in ABC Portal and adopt Samarth e-Gov.

xii. The students enrolled in the institutions, mentioned in Para 2 above, prior to its inclusion under the ambit of Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall, receive their degrees from the University to which these institution was affiliated at the time of their enrollment.

xiii. Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall award degrees only to those students who get enrolled in the institutions, mentioned in Para 2 above, after its disaffiliation from the present affiliating university.

Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, Suraram, Hyderabad, Telangana shall adhere to the instructions of the UGC as contained in the UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2023, as amended from time to time.
