Best Practices Poster Presentation & Video Showcase – 2026

As part of the SAARTHI – Documenting Excellence in Higher Education initiative, Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth (MRV) organized a Best Practices Poster Presentation Competition to showcase institutional innovations and best practices aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

The activity was organized by the University IQAC, Malla Reddy Vishwavidyapeeth, with participation from faculty members, departments, schools, administrative units, and student teams with faculty mentorship. The poster presentation was conducted on 29 July 2026 with the theme “Showcasing Institutional Innovations in Alignment with NEP 2020.”

The competition provided a platform for the constituent colleges and Schools of Eminence to present their innovative initiatives and institutional practices through visually engaging posters. The major areas covered included:

These videos highlighted how NEP 2020 principles are being translated into institutional practices, particularly in teaching-learning, innovation, technology integration, student development, community engagement, and other areas of higher education.
